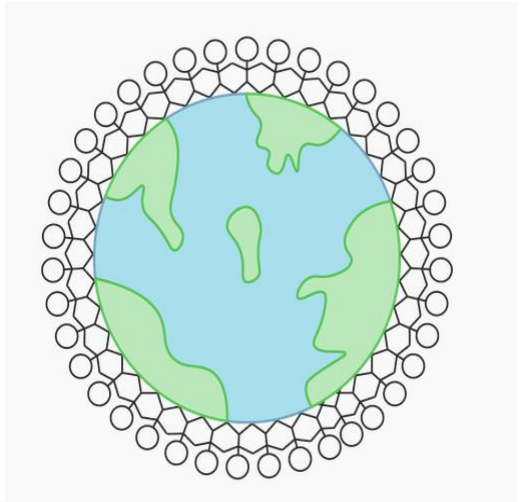

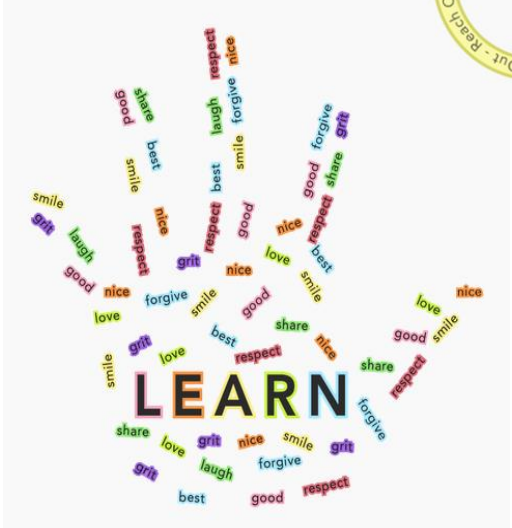
Always do your best – *“Work at everything you do with all your heart.”* Colossians 3 v 23

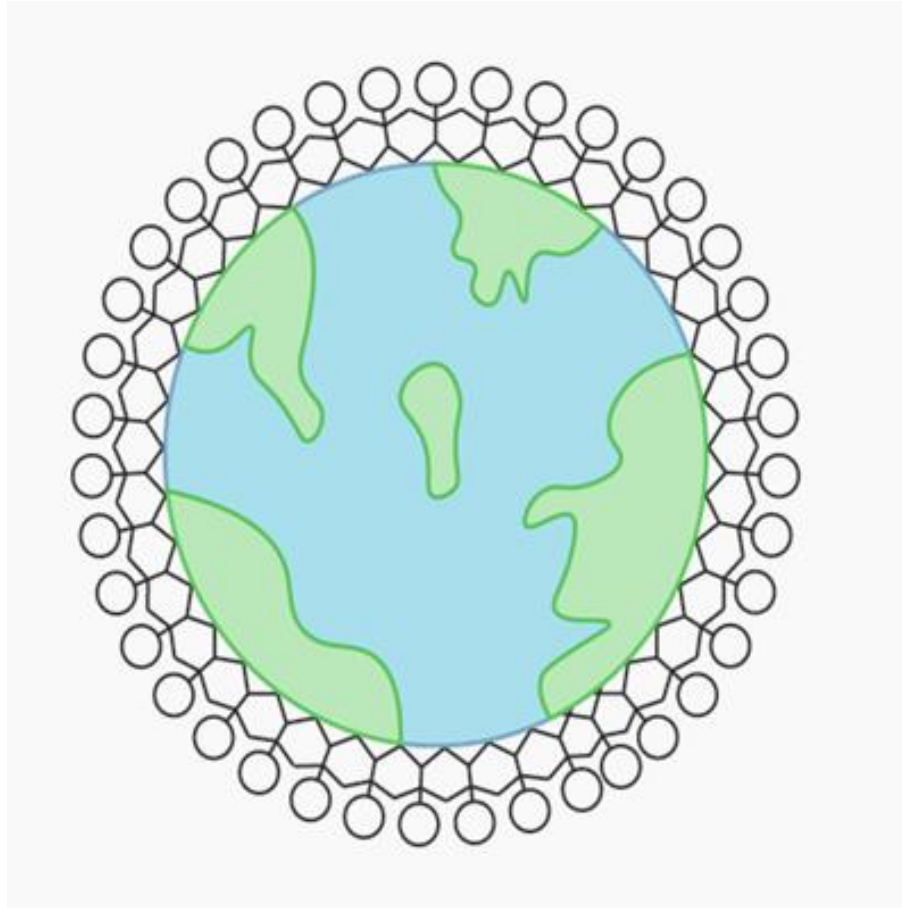
Reach out – *“Do to others as you want them to do to you.”* Luke 6 v 31

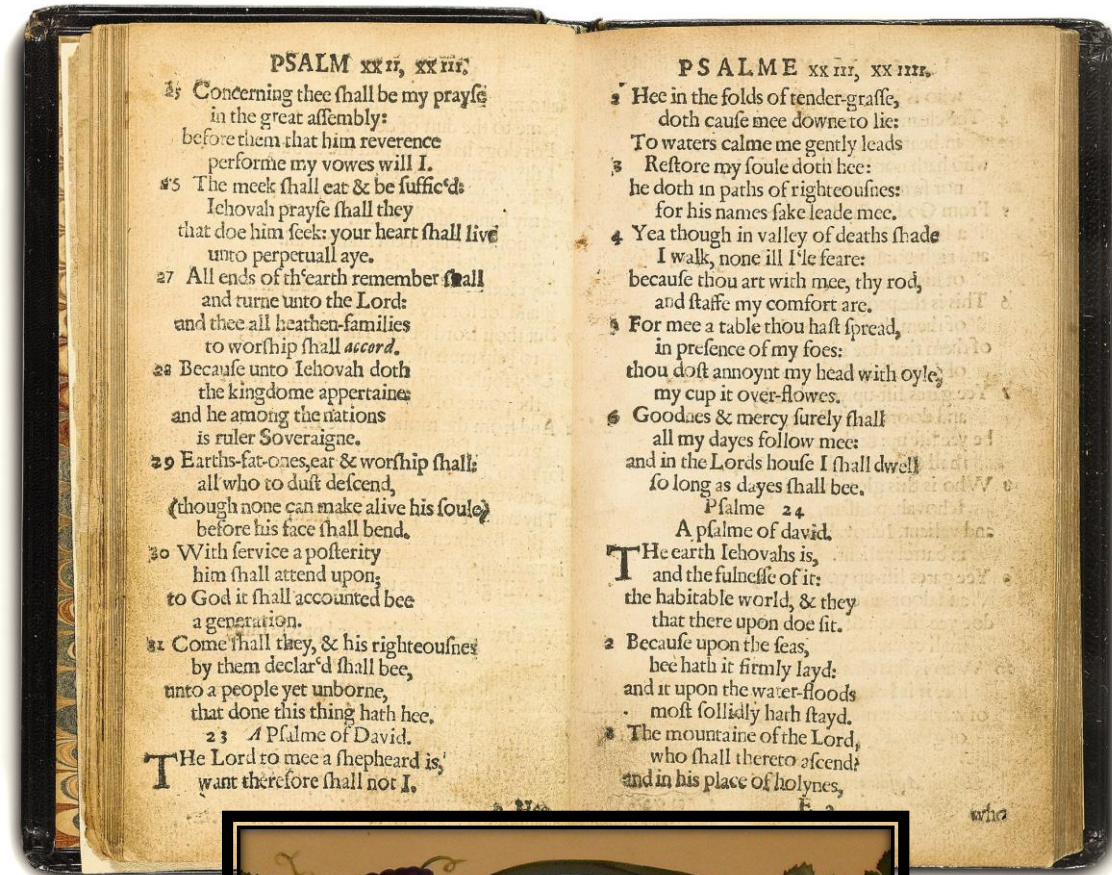


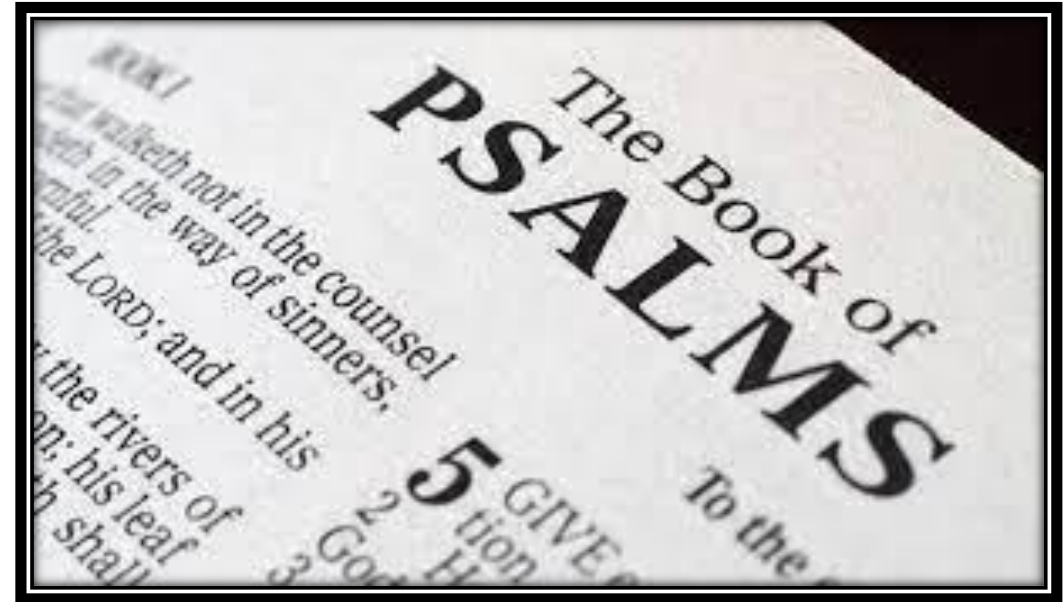
