SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

We are proud of our uniform and believe that wearing one helps us to feel smart and part of our community.

Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the day; this includes having a warm coat for the cold and wet weather. It is also really important that your child's uniform and coats are labelled with their name.

Autumn/Winter

DARK GREY trousers, shorts, knee length skirt or pinafore.

GREY socks, plain grey tights or white knee socks

SKY BLUE OR NAVY BLUE polo shirt

NAVY BLUE sweatshirt or cardigan

Optional school fleece for outdoor wear

BLACK school shoes to be worn in school (no boots)

Sensible outdoor shoes for breaks (trainers, wellies etc.)

Optional – Summer Uniform

PALE BLUE & WHITE checked summer dress

WHITE socks

PE Uniform

WHITE plain T-Shirt

NAVY BLUE shorts

BLACK plimsolls

Optional navy tracksuit or navy hooded sweatshirt for winter.

We will accommodate any families' religious observances and discuss with the family to ensure we meet their needs.

Please do not accessorise your child's uniform with any other items e.g. scarf, jewellery, leggings etc.

Children are requested not to wear nail varnish or have visible temporary tattoos. We understand that after a disco or gala, children may still have temporary tattoos but we ask that these are removed as soon as possible.

Long hair should be tied up with a sensible bobble. Please do not shave symbols or tram lines into your child's hair; 'extreme' hairstyles are not appropriate.

Earrings are permitted, but only small, plain stud earrings. These will need to be taken out or covered over for PE and sports. If your child is in Y3, they will need to remove them before they swim as is Carlton Forum's policy.

We have a second-hand uniform sale every term – these are advertised on the school communications beforehand.



If your child is entitled to free school meals, we will supply you with your child’s first uniform and bag free of charge. See the link to see if you are eligible for free school meals.
