Wishing you all a lovely weekend and week ahead for the half term break. We look forward to welcoming our children back to school on Monday 23rd February.

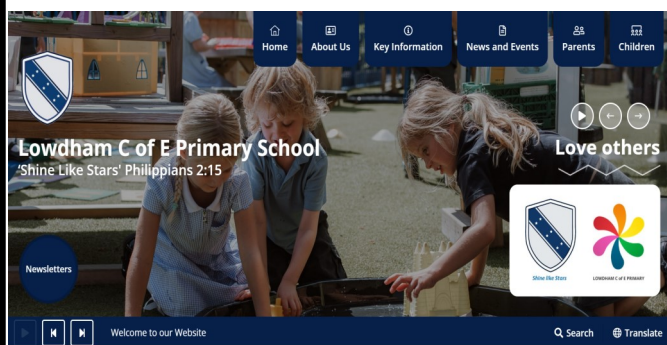
