Dear Heavenly Father,

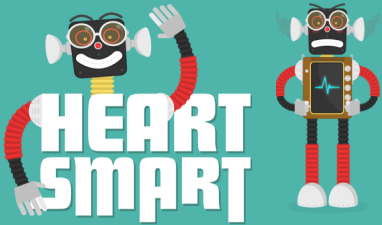

P-We **PRAISE** you for your beautiful creation and for being so amazing.
