World Cup 2026

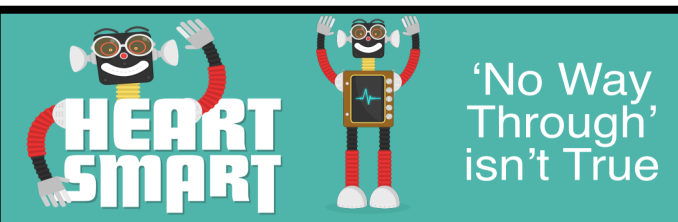
The FIFA World Cup kicked off last Thursday and England started positively with an opening game win against Croatia on Wednesday!

REMINDER: Feeling Hot! Hot! Hot!

Sun Protection– the warm weather is on its way and brings with it the need for protection against the sun. Please ensure that your child has a sun hat and sun protection cream on at school. This should ideally be put on before they leave the house and can be later re-applied at lunch time and playtime by the children themselves. The warm weather also brings out allergies for some children. If your child suffers with hay-fever please give them child approved allergy medication before they come to school each day.



Our final 'Heart Smart High Five' of the academic year is "No way through isn't true!" This half term we have been thinking about our own mindset when faced with challenging situations. Often the first part of finding the solution and way through is by believing that there is one. Speak to your children at home about the work they have been completing in class.

NOTICES: Parking

For those of you who park outside school, even down Main St, we have had a number of complaints from local residents about people choosing to park directly opposite the school and mounting the kerb to do so. This not only blocks off the pavement, meaning that pedestrians are forced to walk on the road to get by, but is often very unsafe. It is especially difficult for anyone with a buggy or wheelchair as there is not enough room to pass by on the pavement. Please take advantage of this warm weather and park further away from school. It would be great to see more parents and children walking to school where possible. This is also a great opportunity to practise times tables or spellings and have a conversation about the school day.
