At the end of the Spring Term we say goodbye and good luck to Miss Colson as she moves on from Lowdham school.

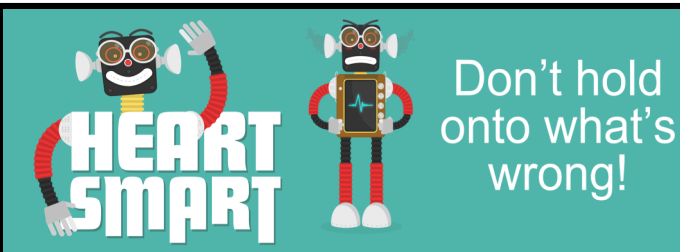
